ARFF Battalion Chief

The Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting department provides emergency services to visitors and employees of the Orlando Sanford International Airport within 3000 acres. The department operates from one station, has 9 full time (24-hour shifts), and 3 part-time (12-hour shifts) of suppression personnel.

POSITION SUMMARY:

- Lead ARFF certified Firefighter/EMTs in response to emergencies on the Airport to include aircraft incidents, hazmat spills, medical emergencies, smoke investigation, bomb threats, public assistance calls, and air side mechanical alarms.
- Coordinate responses with city and county emergency personnel as indicated by type of emergency.
- Perform or assist with any operations, as required to maintain workflow and to meet schedules and quality requirements.
- Assign and participate in the maintenance of apparatus, equipment, and fire station.
- Perform fire department administrative duties
- Maintain yearly compliance with FAA required ARFF training to include pit fires.
- Coordinate and participate in public relations events.
- Complete other duties as assigned.
