Allegiant Air Begins Nonstop Service to Grand Rapids, Michigan from Orlando Sanford

Sanford, FL, February 3, 2009 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) and Allegiant Air, LLC announced the start today of scheduled, nonstop, low-fare service between Orlando Sanford and Gerald R. Ford International Airport (GRR), in Grand Rapids, Michigan. Located nearby Interstates 96 and 196, the airport is ideally situated to serve all of West Michigan.

Service will operate three times weekly on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday.
