**Flyglobespan and Orlando Sanford to Offer Florida's Only
Scheduled Nonstop Flights to Edinburgh, Scotland**

Travel to Edinburgh on flyglobespan from \$339 including taxes

Sanford, FL, September 30, 2009 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) and flyglobespan announce scheduled, nonstop, low-fare service beginning Sunday, June 10, 2010 to Edinburgh Airport (EDI) in Scotland. The new service to Scotland's capital city will operate every Sunday through October 24 and is the only scheduled nonstop service between Edinburgh and the state of Florida. Flyglobespan is offering one-way fares as low as \$339 including taxes for Economy Class and \$1,154 including taxes for Business Class.

Flights will depart Orlando Sanford each Sunday at 6:30 p.m. and arrive in Edinburgh at 7:30 a.m. the next day. Return service is scheduled to leave Edinburgh each Sunday at 1:00 p.m. and arrive at Orlando Sanford at 5:00 p.m. (flight times are local). Reservations can be made on the airline's website at www.flyglobespan.us. The route will be flown on one of the airline's Boeing 767-300 series aircraft with 12 Business class seats and 257 Economy seats available. Flyglobespan also serves Glasgow, Scotland; Belfast, Northern Ireland and Cardiff, Wales nonstop from Orlando Sanford.

Rick Green, Chief Executive Officer with Flyglobespan, said: "We are very excited about this route. It will give our customers a direct link, for the very first time, to Edinburgh and the east of Scotland."
