Allegiant Air Begins Nonstop Service to Owensboro, Kentucky from Orlando Sanford

Sanford, FL, February 18, 2009 – Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) and Allegiant Air, LLC announced the start today of scheduled, nonstop, low-fare service between Orlando Sanford and Owensboro-Daviess County Regional Airport (OWB), in Kentucky. Located on the Kentucky and Indiana border, the airport is situated to conveniently serve mid-western Kentucky and southern Indiana.

Service will operate twice weekly on Wednesday and Saturday. Flights will depart Orlando Sanford at 7:35 a.m. and arrive at Owensboro at 8:40 a.m. Return service will depart Owensboro at 9:20 a.m. and arrive in Orlando Sanford at 12:20 p.m. (all flight times are local). Allegiant will utilize 150-seat, MD-80 series jet aircraft on the route.
